Title:	Stamp the Alphabet
Grade Levels:	K-3

Procedures:	<input type="checkbox"/> Students will use the Kid Pix typewriter tool to type the letters of the alphabet with a capital and lowercase letter. Students then use the Kid Pix stamps to find pictures of things beginning with that letter of the alphabet. <input type="checkbox"/> If students are capable, they should write a sentence using as many of the words for that letter as they can. For example: "An alligator eating an apple covered with ants, climbed in an ambulance after awakening to his alarm clock, so that he could make it to the airplane flight to Anchorage, Alaska."
